## [THE GAZATTE OF INDIA: EXTRAORDINARY (PART-II – SECTION 3 (ii) ] GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF TEXTILES ORDER

New Delhi, the 16th April, 2004

S.O. 507 (E)- Whereas the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its Order dated the 16th February, 2004 in the Internal Application No.5/8 in Civil Appeal No. 6880-6883/2003 in Special Leave Petition No. 15144-15147/2003 in the matter of Union of India & Others Vs. Indian Jute Mills Association & Others vacated the status quo granted by it vide its Order dated the 29th August, 2003;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Jute Packaging Materials (Compulsory Use in Packing Commodities) Act, 1987 (10 of 1987), the Central Government hereby rescinds the Order No. 930 (E) dated the 14th August, .2003, published in the Gazette of India, Extra-Ordinary, Part-II, Section 3, sub-section (ii), dated the 14th August, 2003;
