(v)	Secretary, Department of Chemicals and Petro-Chemicals, Government of India or his representative not below the rank of Joint Secretary.	Member
(vi)	Secretary, Department of Agriculture and Cooperation, Government of India or his representative not below the rank of Joint Secretary.	Member
(vii)	DGS&D, Government of India	Member
(viii)	AS&FA, Ministry of Textiles, Government of India	Member
(ix)	Jute Commissioner, Ministry of Textiles, Government of India.	Member
(x)	Joint Secretary (Jute), Ministry of Textiles, Government of India.	Member-Convener

2. The SAC will recommend the norms of packaging in jute materials, as per the JPM Act, 1987.

3. The validity of the aforesaid constituted SAC will be for a period of 3 years from the date of publication of this Resolution in the Gazette of India.
